**Ahh - the mystery, elegance, and shimmering beauty that is inseparable from the word "S I L K"! Included in this class will be the history of silk production, an introduction to the four main types of silk with samples of their cocoons, yarns, and fabrics, and a discussion of the properties and characteristics of silk and how these relate to the weaving of silk. The 3-day workshop will consist of a round robin in which each participant will weave 8-10 samples of silk fabric using different silks and weave structures. These fabrics are all suitable for clothing (and other finished products of course). Examples of Heather's silk garments and accessories will be on display. Workshop requires pre-warped loom (4 or 8 shaft). Instructions and pre-wound warps will be sent to students 4 weeks before workshop.**

## Heather Winslow

Heather Winslow is a teacher and textile artist who is known and respected nationally. Her educational background is in teaching and after 50 years, she still has a passion to share her knowledge with others. She is chairman of the textile department of The Fine Line Creative Arts Center in St. Charles, Illinois where she teaches weaving, knitting and spinning. She teaches regularly at guilds and shops, and at state, regional, national, and international conferences. Her one-of-a-kind garments have been exhibited internationally and are in several private collections. Her articles have appeared in several fiber related magazines such as Handwoven, Spin-Off, and Weavers, and her garments have been published in a number of books. She is the author of the book, MORE ON MOORMAN: Theo Moorman Inlay Adapted to Clothing

**Requirements: Students should be able to warp a loom and read a draft. Students must provide their own 4 or 8 shaft table or floor loom. Contact Workshop chairperson Nina Kennedy if you need to borrow a loom for the workshop. Looms may be available to borrow from other guild members.**

**Member Registration: Registration is limited to 20 people. To register please complete the registration form that will be available at the guild meeting on March 18<sup>th</sup> and submit to Workshop Chairperson Nina Kennedy along with a check in the amount of \$300.00 made payable to *Weaving Indiana*. Registration/payment will also be available online beginning March 18<sup>th</sup> at the Weaving Indiana website: [weavingindiana.org](http://weavingindiana.org). In the unlikely event that more than 20 people register on the first day of registration, names will be chosen at random from all submitted that day. There is no deposit for this workshop. This is the total fee for the workshop and includes all materials provided by the instructor. Registration closes July 15, 2023.**

**Save \$ by Hosting Instructor: As with past workshops Weaving Indiana will offer free tuition to a person willing to host the instructor, Heather, while she is here for the workshop. This would involve providing lodging for 4 nights as well as breakfasts and dinners.**
