For experienced and beginner weavers

Students should be able to warp a loom and read a draft. Students must provide their own 4 or 8 shaft loom that is in good working order or contact workshop chairperson Nina Kennedy if you would like to borrow a table loom to use in this workshop.

Instructor Beth Duncan would particularly like to invite newer weavers who may have no experience weaving Overshot

This 2-day class covers traditional and contemporary experimentation in overshot. The first day we will work with historically correct blocks and grists of yarn. On the second day we will change gears, playing with colors and textures, especially in the tabby wefts.

The first day of class is all about traditional overshot; history and drafting and then weaving. The second day is pushing our creativity in a different way. If anyone is uncomfortable with the second day, it is fine to keep experimenting and weaving traditionally.

Workshop Instructor Beth Duncan – Fine Line Creative Arts Center, St. Charles, IL

Beth began weaving at age 17, on a home-made loom constructed of 2x4's by her then boyfriend. Self-taught, she wove through high school and college, including one year at the School of the Art Institute of Chicago. Looms and yarns were stored away during a long period of raising children and full-time employment. But the loom came out of storage in January of 2009 and the weaving has been abundant ever since. She has experimented with many woven structures, fine-tuned her color-eye and realized her passion – weaving. Beth is anxious to share what she has learned with others. Since she was self-taught, she is aware of the many benefits of a class situation. She also enjoys spending time with that old loom building boyfriend, who she has been married to for 35 years.
